1. Requests for Funding: Update on approvals and requests

- Rob has bought KS2 Dictionaries and invoiced ptfa so this has been accounted for.
- Miss Hannan's request for additional help with EYFS/Year5/6 Trip as follows:

We would go with our buddies so 62 kids in total. The coach is roughly £1000 and then £9.50 each for entry into Knowsley safari. It works out as £21 each after the £5 from the PTFA. Adults are free within ratio. Ideally, we would ask parents to pay maximum £15 for a school trip.

- i. Calculated the ptfa additional funding @ £6 per child for 62 kids = £372
- ii. Committee agreed to this expenditure this year and will reassess in 2024 to see if the same funding provision might be required on an annual basis.
- Ricky has requested for £50 allocation from The Path fund to spend on wild flower seeds via Paul Knights. Committee agreed to this expenditure.
- Sarah suggested that we could formalise funding requests by using a form which teachers/groups would complete and submit to the ptfa detailing all the specifics of their request in one place. Jenny will design a form and share it with the group.

2. Fund raising events 2023: update

90s Disco at The Trades Club was a big success, with approximately £1000 raised.
Hopefully a similar event can be organised again next year.

• Sarah confirmed that the funds have not reached the ptfa account yet but Sian is organising the bank transfer with The Trades Club and also has cash to be paid into the account, so it should be with us soon.
