IMPORTANT: EXCEPTIONAL LEAVE REQUESTS

Please be aware that The Education (Pupil Registration) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2013, state that Headteachers may not grant any leave of absence during term time unless there are <u>exceptional</u> <u>circumstances</u>. The Headteacher is also required to determine the number of school days a child can be away from school if leave is granted. As parents, you have a legal responsibility to ensure your child's attendance at school. During the academic year, pupils are at school for 190 days and at home for 175 days.

Recently, we have had families come into the office to let us know that their child is going to be off school without filling in the relevant forms. This leads to your child being marked as an 'Unauthorised absence' and can then lead to possible action being taken by the local authority.
