MEETING 2:

School Council members all stated that they are enjoying the breadth of the new curriculum and finding the work both interesting and challenging

1. Behaviour Policy

The school council members have come up with six possible suggestions for House names. It was agreed by all that these suggestions would go o a whole school vote (including teachers & support staff).

2. School Improvement

There are still issues with tidying of equipment at the end of play which impacts the playleaders on duty that day. They are often getting back to class late. It was agreed that school council would take a greater role in ensuring equipment is tidied away. It was suggested that all children in Key Stage 2 should take some responsibility in helping clear the yard after each morning play & lunch play.
